We aim to work in a way which respects your child's rights:

- To be safe
- To be who they are
- To be listened to
- To have their voice heard and valued
- To be recognised and respected
- To express their identity
- To make choices and be supported in them
- To learn and to have fun
- To have their personal information kept safe
- To get the support they need

The information you share with us

We look after your personal information very carefully. We will give you a leaflet about how and where we store your information. We will ask for your consent to share your information with other people so that we can support you better and we will keep asking you.

If you are not happy with how we have worked with you, we will tell you how you can share this with us. We will share information without your permission if we are worried about your safety or someone else's safety.

How can a Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator support me?

Your Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator will have an initial conversation with you. They will consider how to offer support whilst you are waiting for a neurodevelopmental assessment.

Your Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator will offer up to three further interventions that are suited to your needs.

Your Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator will support you to be well informed of options that could be benefit you and your family.

Your Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator will be a listening ear when times are challenging and help your voice to be heard.

Through their work, your Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator will ensure we help to keep your child safe.

Your child is unique and special and your Neurodevelopmental Family Navigator will celebrate their achievements with you and your family.
